Welcome to Year 6! The information below gives an outline of what the children will be learning this term.. We will be doing Forest School on a Monday afternoon so please ensure that children wear their forest school clothes on that day. We will also have PE on a Tuesday afternoon so again please ensure children wear their sports clothes on this day. Both of these commence in the week starting Monday 14th September.

English

Spellings

Homophones; -ible and -able; -ibly and -ably; adding suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words ending in -fer; synonyms and antonyms, alongside ongoing revision of the Year 5-6 word list.

Writing

Retelling; poem from the viewpoint of an inanimate object; diary entry; an argument and a newspaper article.

Reading

Fact retrieval, inference and deduction; figurative language; summarizing.

Drama

Role play; conscience alley; debate; freeze frames; empathy.

Maths

Place Value and the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) to include work with fractions and decimals.

Science

Living things and their habitats - classification of plants and animals; keys; using scientific evidence to support or refute ideas.

Music: Appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians; performing in solo and ensemble contexts and understanding musical notation.

Humanities: Changes in an aspect of history: wars & battles from 1066 to the present.

French: Notre école - our school.

PE: Forest School (Monday) & Playpals training (Tuesday).

PSHE: What affects mental health and ways to take care of it; managing change, loss and bereavement; managing time online.

RE: Is it better to express your religion in arts and architecture or in charity and generosity?

Art: Frida Kahlo - a study of her work and creation of original pieces based on influence and style, to include drawing and painting techniques.

Computing: Online safety.
