The information below gives an outline of what the children will be learning this term. PE will be on a Wednesday and Thursday this term so please ensure that kits are in school on those days.

English

Spellings

Words ending in -able; words ending in -ably; word families, including common words; creating diminutives using prefixes mico- or mini-; words from the Y5/6 statutory spelling list.

Writing

Newspaper report; instructions; diary entry; formal speech; setting description; thriller writing.

Reading

Information retrieval; inference and deduction; use of language; word meaning; summarizing.

Drama

Freeze frames; debate; role play; empathy and listening.

Maths

Factors; common factors; common multiples; calculations with fractions (four operations); fractions of amounts; fraction, decimal & percentage equivalences; percentages; word problems; position and direction.

Science

Animals including humans - the human circulatory system; the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood; the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way our bodies function; and how nutrients and water are transported within animals.

Music: Using our bodies as instruments, performing in solo and ensemble contexts, recording graphic scores and understanding musical notation.

Humanities: Wars and battles from 1066 to the present day (*continued*).

French: Notre monde - the world around us.

PE: Netball and hockey.

Art: Drawing - depicting movement.

DT: Study of mechanical systems through creation of a pop-up book.

RE: Is it better to express your beliefs in arts and architecture or in charity and generosity? (*continued*)

PSHE: Keeping safe.
