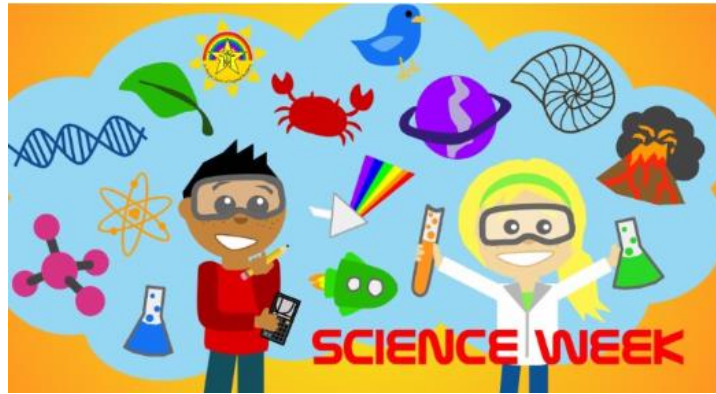

This week is Science week, so we will be doing Science every day!




We will be welcoming some very special guests into the classroom, and I am sure that the children will tell you all about them!
