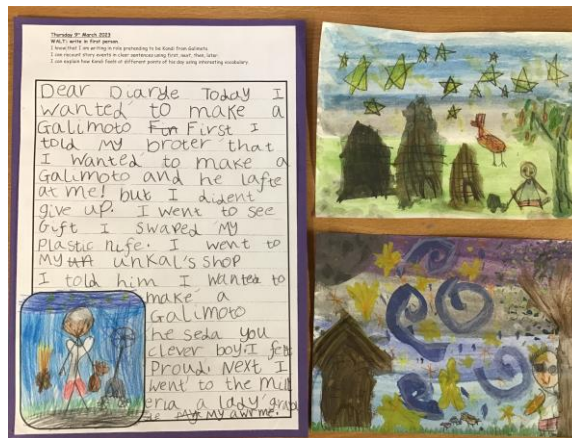
### First Signs of Spring
