We hope you all had a lovely half term! The children have been amazing at getting 'stuck in' with our new learning this term. It is so lovely to see the fantastic progress they are making! Some of our learning this week has included:

- <u>Maths</u> We have begun learning about 'place value to 50'. We have focussed on learning to group objects in tens and ones when counting to make our counting more efficient and have learnt to present the tens and ones making these numbers with resources and through drawings.
- <u>English</u> We have begun our unit on writing stories with a familiar setting. We have used adjectives to describe settings and have used the conjunction 'and' to join sentences together when writing.
- <u>Geography</u> We finished our topic on maps this week. We used our knowledge of maps to design our very own playground and to draw an ariel map of our playground. The children had some great ideas!
