- Maths - We have finished our place value to 50 unit this week. We have learnt to find missing numbers on number lines up to 50 and have found one more and one less than numbers up to 50. Some of the children have found recognising numbers up to 50 a little tricky, so this is our maths homework focus this week.
- English - We have begun reading the book 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers in our reading lessons. We have retold and sequenced the story of Jack and the Beanstalk in our writing lessons.
- History - Thank you for supporting your child with their history homework last week. It has been so lovely to hear about the old toys they spoke about with their family members, and this really helped with our comparison work in our lesson.

Forest school/Cricket - Just a reminder that forest school takes place on Tuesday afternoons this term and cricket takes place on Thursday afternoons.
